Plug Plants

Special sedum, herb and grass plug plants for planting on extensive green roofs in various container sizes.



Plant species	Various sedum, herb and grass plug plants
Container size	Containers of 3, 4 and 5/6
Recommended quantity	For containers of 3: 20-25 pieces/m ² For containers of 4: 16-20 pieces/m ² For containers of 5/6: min. 16 pieces/m ²
Delivery form	Packed in cardboard boxes for small quantities, otherwise in container panels on air-permeable special pallets
Quantity/ delivered unit	Full container panels of one variety 160 pieces of container panel with 3 100 pieces of container panel with 4 50 pieces of container panel with 5/6 mixed container panels and small quantities on request with minimum order supplement.

Area of use

One single- or multi-layer extensive green roofs up to approx. 250 mm layer thickness.

Care recommendation

- The plants planted each day are to be watered thoroughly on the same day, i.e. the substrate layer must be completely saturated with water to stimulate root formation (usually the case if the water is clearly draining out).
- It is recommended to contract out completion care in the performance contract and, where applicable, agree development and/or maintenance care.

Specific properties

The plug plants are produced in accordance with the “quality requirements for perennials” and in accordance with DIN 18916 and correspond to the quality features of the FLL Green Roofing Guideline.

In particular, they display the following characteristics:

- Cultivation in special substrates with a high mineral content
- Not in an excessively fertilised condition
- Strong, species-appropriate budding
- Cultivation in containers and container panels max. 50 mm height

Storage

The delivered plug plants can be stored in a cool, shady place in the original packaging for around 3 days, including transport times. After this, the pallets should be completely unpacked in a cool, shady place, displayed in one layer and kept moderately damp.

The preceding details are guideline values established under laboratory conditions. These values are subject to a certain manufacturing tolerance.
